Special Called Council Meeting

The Nauvoo Town Council met for a Special Called Council Meeting on November 4, 2025 at 5:00 p.m. at the Nauvoo Town Hall. The purpose of the meeting was to pass a resolution to amend CDBG funds for CDBG project #SM-CM-PF-23-002 – demolition of a former church, school, and cafeteria building. Mayor Burgett in the chair and clerk Nicole Garner acting as recording secretary. Mayor Burgett called the meeting to order at 5:00 pm. The following council members were present upon roll call: Olivia Allbritton, Deborah Barton, Christian Dill, Denice Perry, Melinda Wills, and Terry Burgett. Guests in attendance were Keya Kraft and Justin McCleskey of the Regional Planning Commission of Greater Birmingham. Barton opened the meeting with a prayer and Dill led in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Burgett explained that the CDBG project is complete and that the project ran under budget and that a budget amendment was necessary to reflect the cost under-run and to close the grant. Dill then moved to pass Resolution 20251104: A Resolution Authorizing the Submission of a Formal Amendment Request to Return Unused Community Development Block Grant Funds to Alabama of Economic and Community Affairs. Barton seconded the motion and upon a roll call vote was as follows: YEAS – Allbritton, Barton, Dill, Perry, Wills; NAYS – None. Motion carried.

Barton moved to adjourn the meeting with Dills seconding the motion. All were in favor and the meeting adjourned at 5:03 pm.
