Special Called Council Meeting

The Nauvoo Town Council met for a Special Called Council Meeting on March 4, 2026 at 10:00 a.m. at the Nauvoo Town Hall. Mayor Burgett in the chair and clerk Nicole Garner acting as recording secretary. Mayor Burgett called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m. The following council members were present upon roll call: Olivia Allbritton, Deborah Barton, Christian Dill, Denice Perry, and Terry Burgett. Council member Melinda Wills was absent. Visitors present were Nick McDonald, Matt Sanford, Gary Knight, and Drew Sanford.

Mayor Burgett explained that the meeting was being called to discuss the lighting needs at the ball fields and asked for a motion to suspend the rules of the council for the immediate consideration of the lighting needs. Dill moved to suspend the rules. Allbritton seconded the motion and upon a roll call vote was as follows: YEAS – Allbritton, Barton, Dill, Perry, Burgett; NAYS – None. Motion carried. Mayor Burgett went over a few different options and the pricing for each option that was received from James Aldridge. Allbritton moved to approve the expenditure of up to \$32,000 out of the building fund for the following projects: lighting project to supply secondary voltage to both fields for the total of \$23,900 and the purchase of 6 poles for around \$5,300 (not included in the quote from Aldridge). The lighting project would include secondary voltage on the upper field plus installation of 16 new LED lights on 4 poles with underground secondary on the lower field; it will not include the purchasing of the poles but does include digging the holes and setting the poles. The purchase of the poles with delivery is estimated to be around \$5,300. Dill seconded the motion and upon a roll call vote was as follows: YEAS – Allbritton, Barton, Dill, Perry; NAYS – None. Motion carried.

Barton moved to adjourn the meeting with Dill seconding the motion. All were in favor and the meeting adjourned at 10:19 a.m.
