

TOWN OF NAUVOO
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Special Called Council Meeting

The Nauvoo Town Council met for a Special Called Council Meeting on July 27, 2026 at 10:00 a.m. at the Nauvoo Town Hall. Mayor Burgett in the chair and clerk Nicole Garner acting as recording secretary. Mayor Burgett called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m. The following council members were present upon roll call: Olivia Allbritton, Deborah Barton, Denice Perry, Melinda Wills, and Terry Burgett. Council member Chirstian Dill was absent.

Mayor Burgett explained that the meeting was being called to discuss proposed change orders for the Water Tank Rehabilitation project - FS010194-02. The first change order would allow for the addition and installation of 3" Watts PRV "LFF 115" (lead-free, 3-inch pressure-reducing valve). The additional price for the change order would be \$9,500.00 which will be taken from the ADEM loan for the project. Allbritton moved to accept the change order. Barton seconded the motion and upon a roll call vote was as follows: YEAS – Allbritton, Barton, Perry, Wills; NAYS – None. Motion carried.

The next change order was to have a Nauvoo Raider painted on the side of the water tank during the Water Tank Rehabilitation project - FS010194-02. The change order would cost \$12,000.00. The change order was discussed and it was decided that the \$12,000 could be spent in more needed areas of the water system. Wills moved to reject the change order to have a Nauvoo Raider painted on the water tank. Barton seconded the motion and upon a roll call vote was as follows: YEAS – Allbritton, Barton, Perry, Wills; NAYS – None. Motion carried.

Barton moved to adjourn the meeting with Wills seconding the motion. All were in favor and the meeting adjourned at 10:17 a.m.
